Applicability: Can be used for all types of workbenches.

Purpose of test.

The purpose of this test is to check the strength and functionality of the casters after being tested in free fall strike the floor.

Test Setup:

1 rubber mat 2mm thick, with hardness (85 +/- 5)

Drop Height in mm = 150 mm.

Value = 10 Times.

Test Procedures This test refers to movable workbenches or tables. Lift the workbench at one end, and then allow it to fall freely from the height specified in table

3 (Drop height in mm=150), so that the impacting feet or casters strike the floor (A.2.4). Carry out the test 10 times.

A.2.4. Floor, horizontal, flat and rigid with a smooth melamine surface. For the drop test (A.3.7) a rubber mat 2 mm tick, with hardness (85+/-5) IRHD according ISO 48, on a concrete floor.

After testing the wheels did not lose their functionality.
